

Ensuring that each European student can be uniquely identified across borders and across digital tools, will facilitate the roll out of European Student Cards across Europe and enable the complete digitalisation of the management of Erasmus+ student mobilities from application to issuing of study credentials"



UNIC – a practical application of the ESI



- ESI will need to be stored on local systems
- ESI will also need to be stored on EU systems
- Will need a trusted and secure means of transferring data – API?
- Using existing EU-trusted infrastructure

Person registers for a course

ID no. is generated

AD account is created based on this ID


ID card is printed

Credentials allow access to digital services such as:

- Student registration portal
- Canvas
- Umail
- Library online resources
- Timetable
- Booking study rooms etc.... (SOME USE EDUGATE)
- Erasmus

ID Cards allow physical access to services such as:

- Library and other access-controlled areas
- Campus
 Accomodation
- Book borrowing
- Equipment rental




What about Security, GDPR?



"Every time an App or website asks us to create a new digital identity or to easily log on via a big platform, we have no idea what happens to our data in reality. That is why the Commission will propose a secure European e-identity. One that we trust and that any citizen can use anywhere in Europe to do anything from paying your taxes to renting a bicycle. A technology where we can control ourselves what data is used and how."
